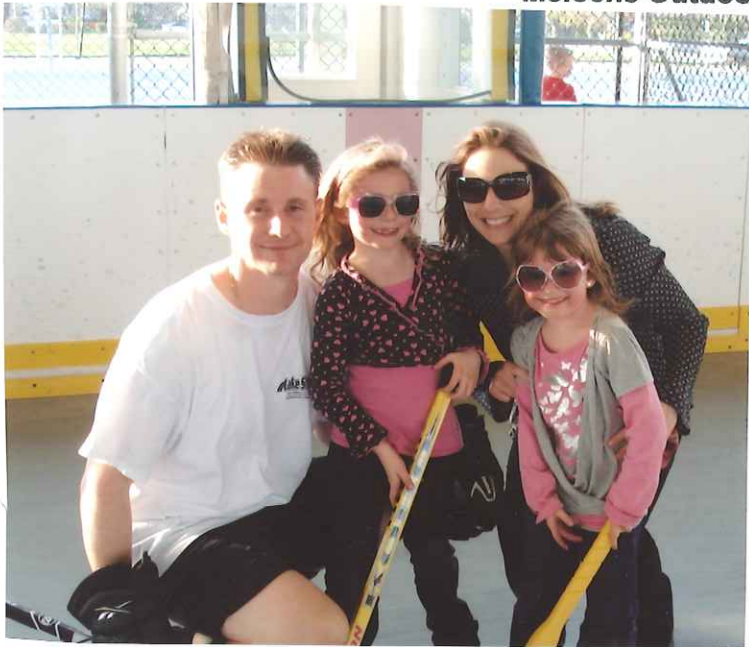

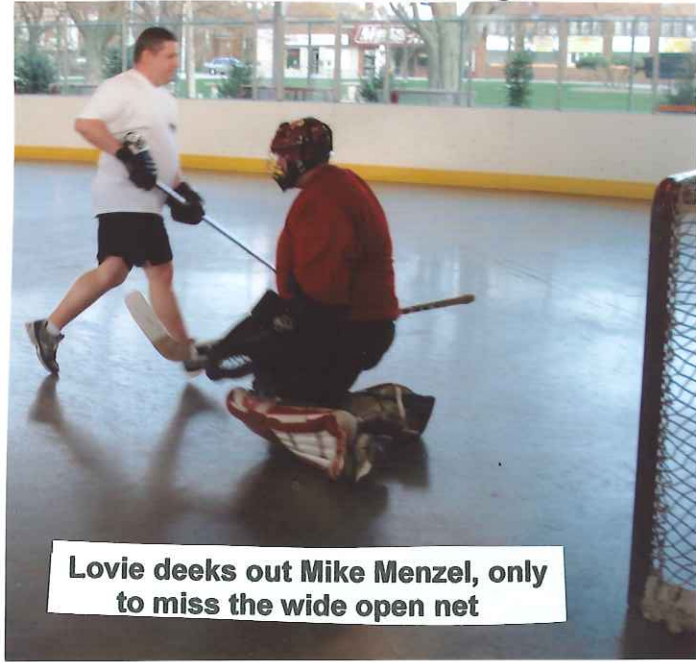
Out Door Game Bigger and Better.
