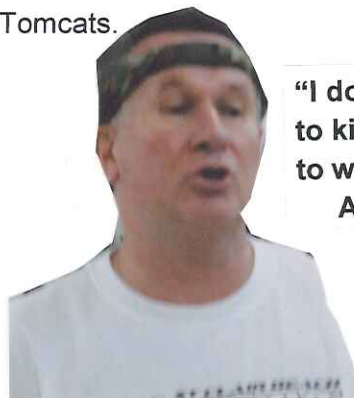

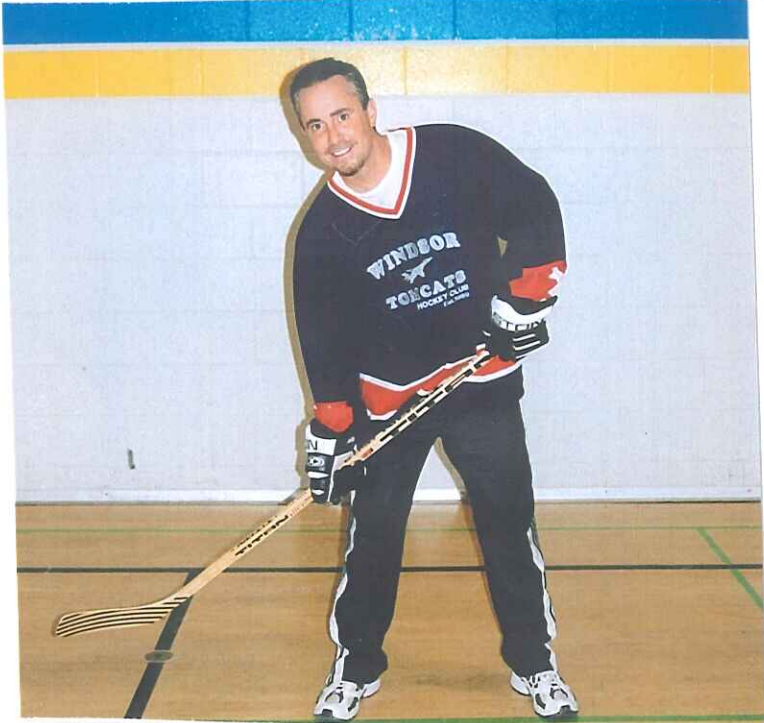
“I don’t want to see Stevo quitting, he can’t! He is the heart and soul. Why can’t these lazy mother fuckers write something.....anything?”
