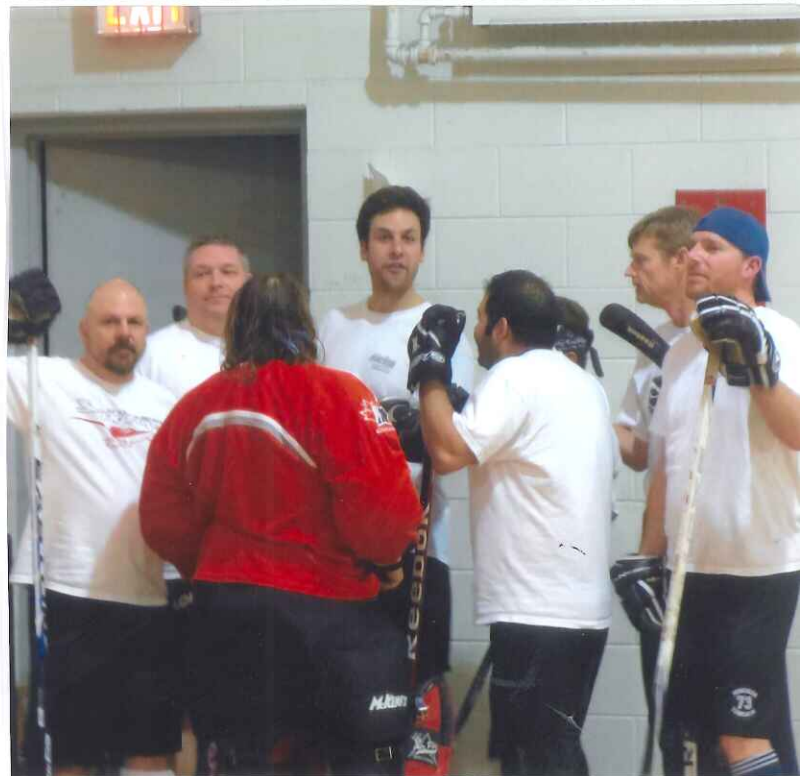
Fines Spelled Out

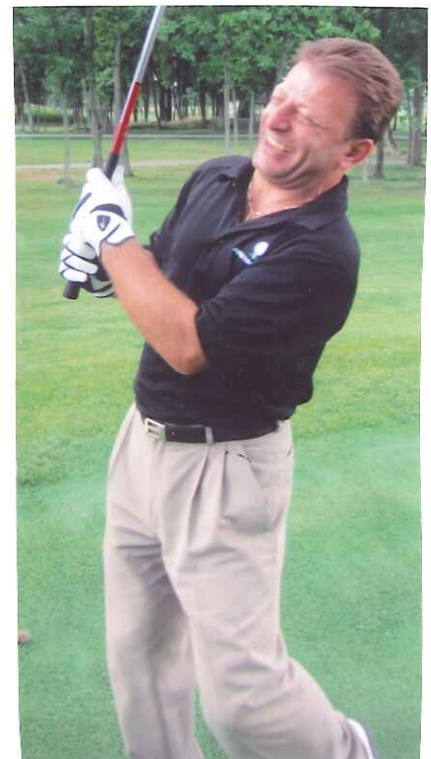
