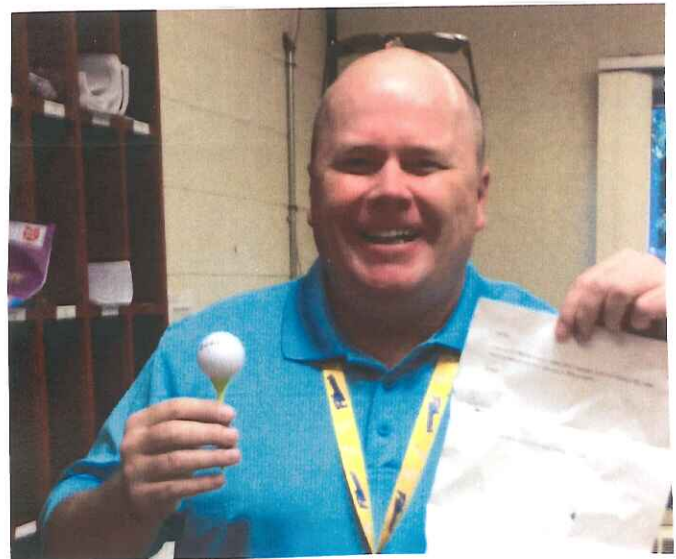




Tomcats Show Case 3 Hollohazy, Lamb and Antoun

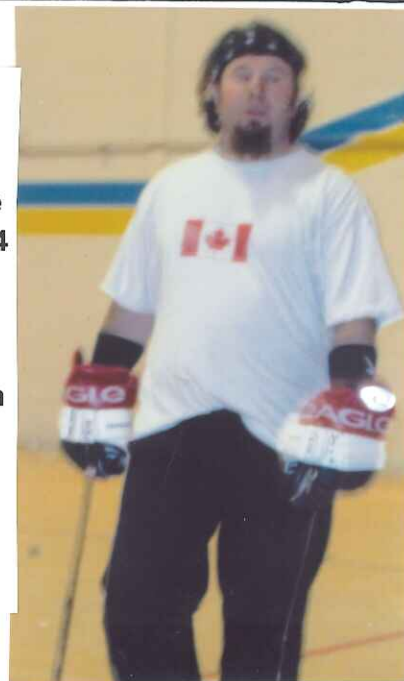
