Cribzie Calling it Quits

Back Problems Cited As Reason

Windsor-AP- Diehart Windsor Tomcat is calling it a career and is retiring from the Windsor Tomcats. At a Press Conference on August 27, at the Kapusta Kow Palace Ken Cribley choked back tears as he made the announcement. "I promised Gretz I would not cry," He started off, then small crocodile like tears rolled down his eyes as he continued, "What a great bunch of guys, what a great time playing and what a great time sitting up on stage, I will miss it all, I will miss the fans and I will miss the Tomcats". Cribley Stated.

Medical reason, believed to be his back was believed to be the main reason for the sudden announcement. The Tomcats will have a difficult time filing his minutes On the floor as Cribley played a lot of minutes, being a specialist on the penalty kill and getting some power play time

The Windsor Tomcat Camaraderie resumes....


