Sheep Dogs From Outer Space

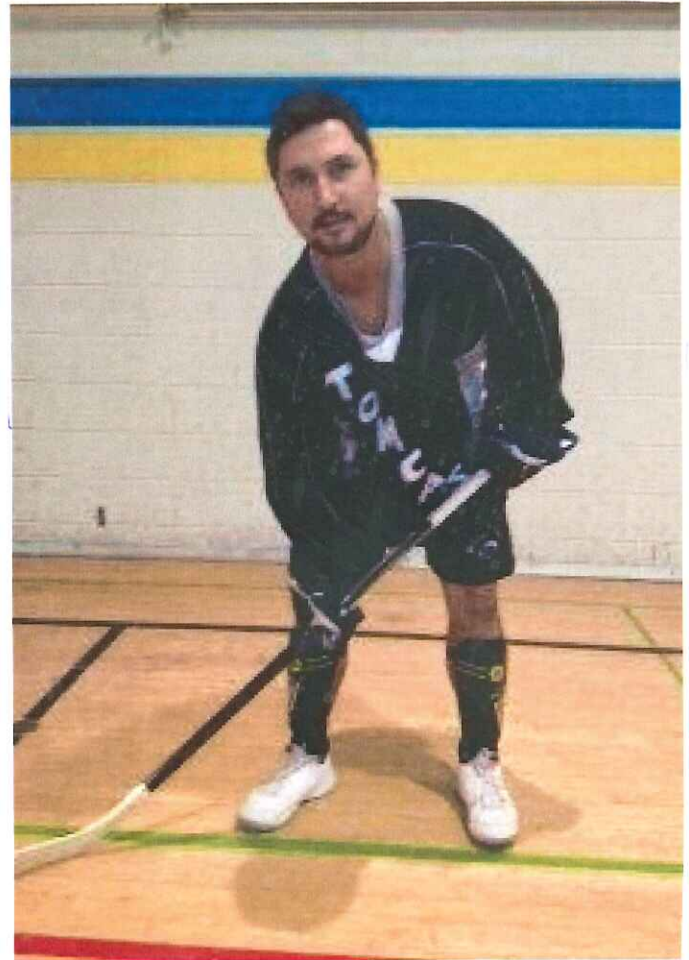

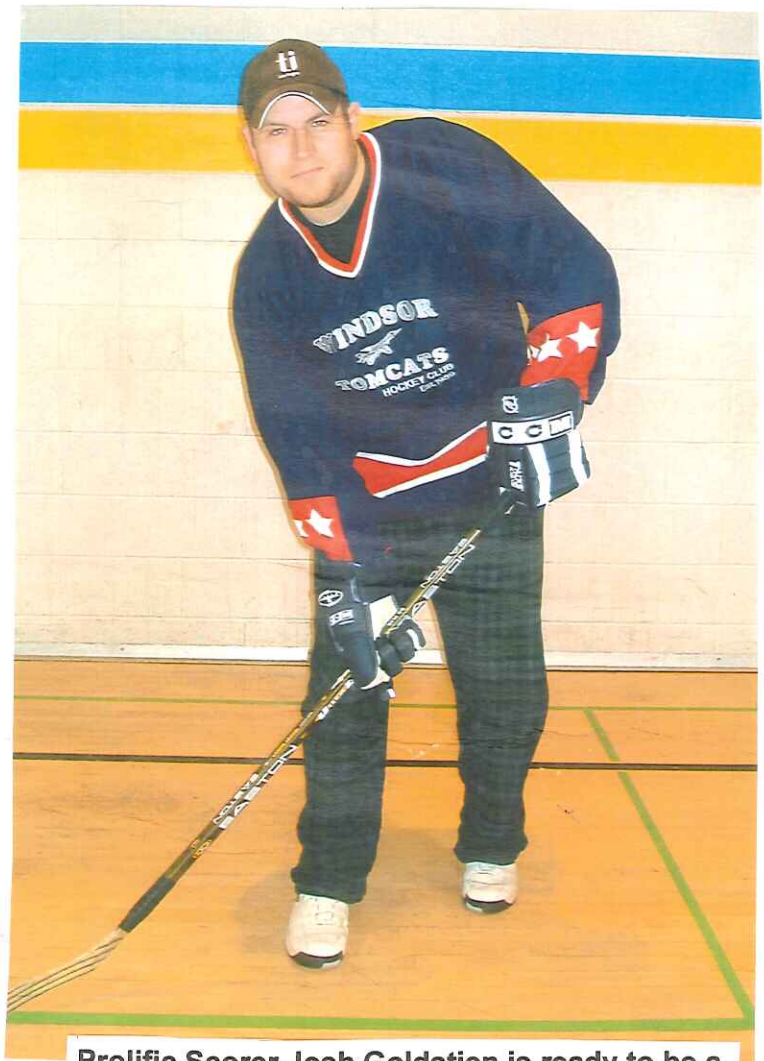
