Tomcats are not saying stop saying "Sparky Blows Snowpants", before a game is to start, all they are saying is don't be a bear.....be fair and be aware!




Read, Read!





Big Change, First Time Ever


So you wanted to be a Tomcat all your life and just can't let go. But you have not been showing up either. Well, the benevolent Tomcats 20 years ago would never of asked you to quit, but now, well, like Bob Dylan once sang, "Times, they are a changing".

Simple new way of handling things. IF your attendance falls to 50% or less, during the season, you will be notified. Tomcats will use first ten games as a gauge. If you have shown up for 5 of those games, expect an email from the big Presedente! If you show up for 6 out of 10 weeks, then you will be fine. 7 out of 12 times, you will be fine.....11 out of 20 times you will be fine. Here is the kick in the teeth...if at the end of the 2015-16 Season your attendance is 50% or less than 50% then you will AUTOMATICALLY be relegated as a part time Tomcat. (No accommodation policy in effect with the Tomcats) Part time players are called on a 'need be' basis. This will mean that you will be called during the 2016-17 season when the Tomcats need you, not when you figure you can shanty out to Play.

Once relegated to part time...you can only get full time status If a full time player quits. Seniority is in play here. You would still be ahead of a part time player who has only played for 3 years where as you may have 14 years. You DO NOT get Bumped to the very back of the line...after all Windsor is a union town.
