



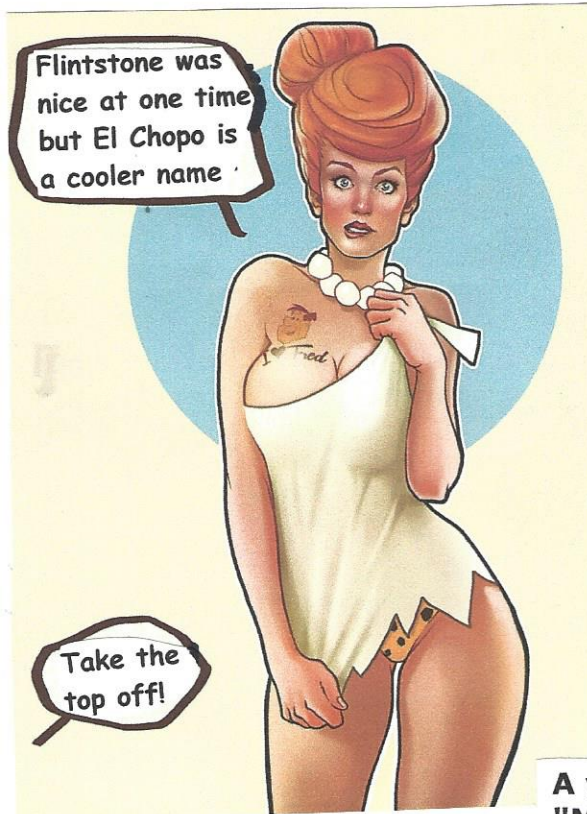
Flintstone to get new Nickname ?? Unprecedented

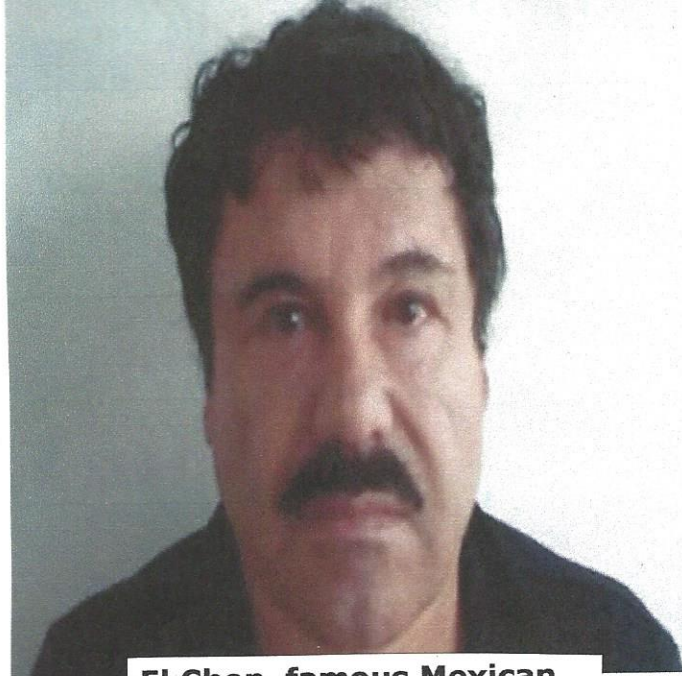


Nick Wilson named after this famous character due to similar looks.
