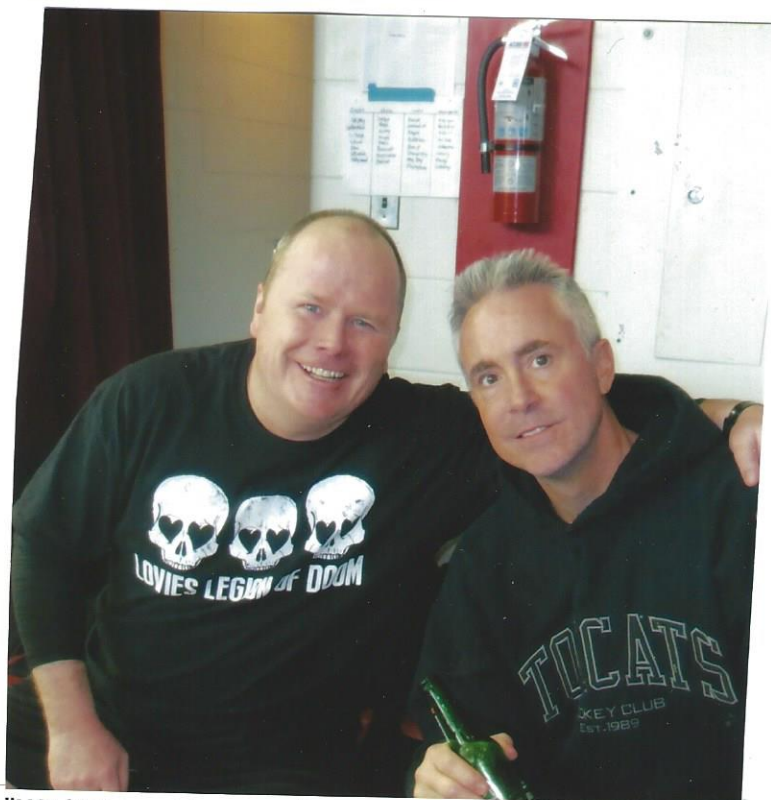

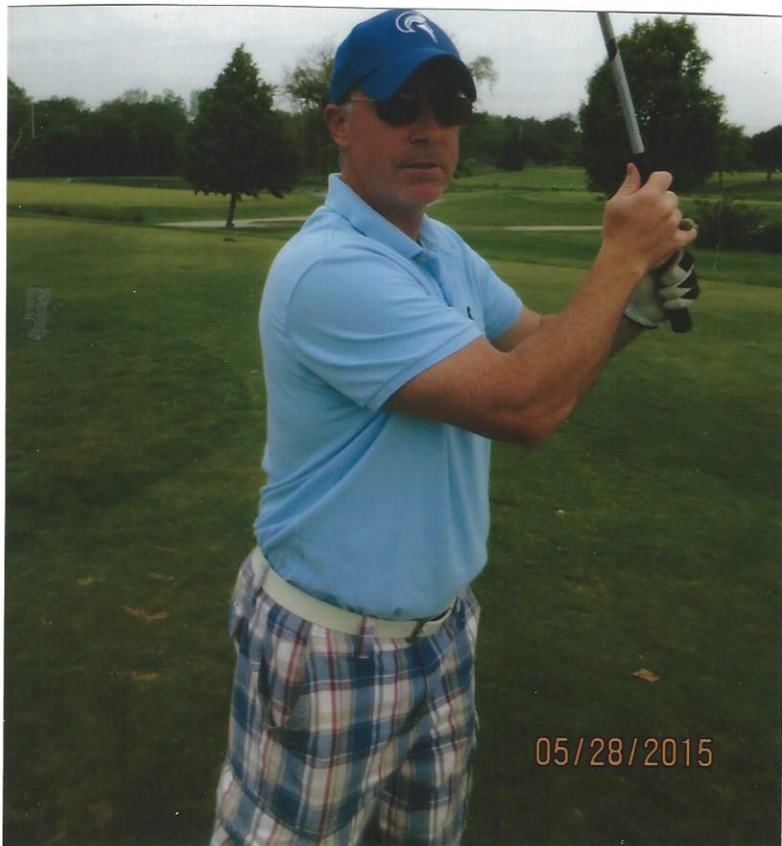
next year's Stanley's Cup Tournament..... but the big one will be Stevo stepping down." stated Paul Renaud.
